28 Names of God in the Old Testament

Throughout the Old Testament, we see various names of God that reveal His character and His ways. Many times, when God worked mightily in a person's life, he or she called God by a new name. For example, when God took care of Hagar after being cast away in the desert, she came to know him as Jehovah Roi – the God who sees. When God provided the ram in the thicket for Abraham, he came to know God as Jehovah Jireh – the LORD will provide. And when God reveled Himself to David as the Shepherd, David came to know Him as Jehovah-rohi – the LORD our Shepherd.

Many are comfortable thanking God for what He has done, but are not accustomed to praising God for who He is. One way to spend time praising God simply for who He is, is by praying His various names found in the Old Testament. Below is a partial list.
