Day 1

1. Read Chapter One in *A Sudden Glory*.
2. Can you relate to Stephanie in the opening email? Have you ever felt that way?
3. Write the definition of “glory ache” found on page 4 in your *Sudden Glory Journal*.
4. Write the definition of “a sudden glory” found on page 12
5. Memorizing these two definitions will help you as you go through the study.
6. Answer to share: What do you hope to get out of this study?

Day 2

1. Answer questions 1-6 of Lesson 1 in the Study Guide.
2. Share your answer for question 2 in the comment box: Can you give some examples of things we labor for or search for that will not satisfy our heart's glory ache?
3. Looking at question 4, how is a broken or cracked cistern representative of anything we would use to fill the glory ache other than a relationship with Jesus? Share your answer in the comment box.
4. Please share any other question and answer that caused you to stop and consider your own life.

Day 3

1. Answer questions 6-10 of Lesson 1 in the Study Guide.
2. Question 6 asked you to consider Jesus' invitation: "If anyone is thirsty, let him come to me and drink." What would that "look like" in your life? Share your answer in the comment box.
3. Looking at question 8, which one of David's longings are the most reflective of your own?
4. Please share any other question and answer that caused you to stop and consider your own life.

Day 4
